THE SHOW



Parade - The Giant Wheel is a moving performance inspired by the beauty, power, and impact of people from different walks of life coming together, featuring a **12foot tall Giant Wheel** powered by **6 street artists** and accompanied by music and a **large community cast** of local groups and individual performers.

Autin Dance Theatre uses their unique blend of contemporary storytelling, striking physicality and innovative large designs to transport audiences and communities along a carefully choreographed procession.

The **50-minute** itinerant act is punctuated by **3 static moments** that celebrate the tension and fracture between our individual identities and our shared collective humanity. Ultimately, Parade is about celebrating different journeys whilst honouring our shared life struggles and collective journeys.

The Giant Wheel carries the performers high above the streets, spins them around ferociously, turning their worlds upside down, at times giving them momentum and speed, and at others rocking them gently back and forth imitating the laborious and repetitive cycle of life.

Parade is an ambitious and scalable street performance that has inclusivity and accessibility at its heart. Local participants can join Parade's community engagement plans including opportunities for groups to perform alongside the procession and for individuals to join the movement of mass participation.



FARABE THE GIANT WHEEL

PRODUCTION INFORMATION

- **Parade The Giant Wheel** is suitable for family and festival audiences (5 to 95 y/o)
- **Parade The Giant Wheel** requires 3 spaces and a procession route.

Starting Static Performance 1 (The Roundabout) - 6m x 6m

Static Performance 2 (The Hamster Wheel) - 3m x 8m

Static Performance 3 (The Revolve) - 7m x 7m

- The company can perform the full show up to a maximum of 2 times per show day, with a minimum of 90 mins between the end of 1 performance and the start of the next one. (Ideal programming showtimes are 1pm & 4pm)
- **The Sound, Power and a tricycle.** Accompanying the wheel, will be a tricycle. The tricycle will be carrying a portable electric generator, the mixing desk and the PA system.
- **Terrains.** Static and promenade performances require: Smooth flat flooring, pavement/ roads is preferable. Grass is subject to being dry/flat and hard (not plush/thick grass).
- Parking spaces are required for 1 car and 1 long wheel base van.
- Number of people on the road (8): 6 Performers, 1 Production Assistant & 1 Director. The Production Assistant will operate the music.









AUDIENCE ACCESS

Please note that the show doesn't contain any text or spoken word. All the storytelling is expressed through movement and physicality.

Audio Description

Autin Dance Theatre always strives to make its work inclusive and accessible for all audiences. With this in mind, we welcome festival promoters and event organisers to support us with live audio description of **Parade – The Giant Wheel**. Community Cast - Participation Opportunities

Autin Dance Theatre invites and calls upon individuals, community groups, educational establishments to take part in a live performance of Parade - the Giant Wheel. The opportunity will engage, inspire and upskill local participants, residents and creatives in the region with of artistic and social impact for the community and beyond.

Our experienced dance artists along community coordinators will lead you through physical theatre, storytelling, and procession choreography. They will help you tell own stories and support the co-creation of a full movement of the procession.

Each workshop includes our signature warm ups – plus accessible movement exercises, creative wellbeing check-ins, group discussions, and techniques use in dance theatre. The community sessions are open to people of all experiences and abilities. The workshops are highly accessible, and the movement content is suitable for those with reduced mobility, offering differentiation options to cater to all abilities.

The workshops are specifically aimed at intergenerational communities including children aged 6+, young people and their families, and adults from local communities & school groups, including people with physical or learning disabilities, those with challenging behaviour, groups in areas of social deprivation and all local residents.
















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
