

Brimstone – The Dragon is a roaming theatrical experience that sparks imagination, instils wonder, and imparts subtle lessons in a way that resonates with children and their families.

The 6-metre long Giant Dragon puppet designed by Mr Cleaver's Monsters, is brought to life by 4 highly skilled puppeteers to tell the magical and adventurous story of Brimstone, a fearsome and misunderstood beast from a hidden island.

The interactive promenade adventure will involve the dragon, who will search high, low, around, and through the crowds and public spaces searching for his long-lost friend.

PRODUCTION INFORMATION



- **Brimstone The Dragon** is suitable for family and festival audiences (target audience 5+)
- **Brimstone The Dragon** requires a minimum playing space for **the roaming act**: 2.5m height clearance outdoor (due to the heights and size of the puppet) and at least 1.5m wide walkabout performance space on any grounds (any terrain works: grass, sand, etc.).
- Wet Weather Contingency: the company can perform under light rain and other optional indoor locations
- Running time: approx. 25-minute performance (as a roaming act /promenade)
- The company can perform the act up to a maximum of 3 times per show day, with a minimum of 30 mins in between -> Ideal programming showtimes are 11am, 1:30pm & 1pm
- Parking spaces are required for 1 car and 1 long wheel base van.
- Number of people on the road (5): 4 Performers, 1 Production Assistant.

AUDIENCE ACCESS

Please note that the show doesn't contain any text or spoken word. All the storytelling is expressed through movement and physicality.

Accessibility is at the heart of *Brimstone – The Dragon*. The roaming performance is designed to be welcoming and inclusive for everyone. Each event features an **Accessible Viewing Area** with clear sightlines and close proximity to the action, ensuring an enjoyable experience for all audience members. We offer **Touch Tours** before performances, giving blind and visually impaired members of the public the chance to explore key elements of the puppet, meet performers, and experience the textures and materials that bring the story to life. An **Easy Read Guide** is also available, providing clear and simple information about the show's themes, characters, and structure.

We strongly encourage and support the coordination of **Live Audio Description** and **BSL interpretation** for opening and closing speeches, the main performance, and outreach activities, working closely with event partners to make this possible. Our team is committed to creating an environment where all audiences can feel included, informed, and inspired.
