PRODUCTION INFORMATION

- **Chronos the Giant Wheel** is suitable for family and festival audiences (5+)
- Minimum Performance Spaces Required

Static Performance: 6m (wide) x 12m (long) - negotiable (flat even surface)
We provide 6 x 4 = 24 x 1m square black MMA mats (jigsaw)

- Show Duration: 35 minutes

The company can perform the full show up to a maximum of 3 times per show day, with a minimum of 90 mins between the end of 1 performance and the start of the next one.

- **Terrains:** The Static performances require a smooth flat and even flooring surface, pavement/roads and public square are suitable. Any terrain works such as gravel, sand and park/grass is subject to being dry and flat
- Number of people on the road (7): 5 Performers, 1 Director & 1 Technical Manager
- We will require up to 3 parking spaces, depending on the cast & crew. 1 for a long wheelbase van and 2 for cars. (Up to 7 people on the road) depending on venue location and cast.

AUDIENCE ACCESS

Please note that the show doesn't contain any text or spoken word. All the storytelling is expressed through movement and physicality.

Accessibility is at the heart of *Chronos – The Giant Wheel*. The performance is designed to be welcoming and inclusive for everyone. Each event features an **Accessible Viewing Area** with clear sightlines and close proximity to the action, ensuring an enjoyable experience for all audience members.

We offer **Touch Tours** before performances, giving blind and visually impaired members of the public the chance to explore key elements of the wheel, meet performers, and experience the textures and materials that bring the story to life.

An **Easy Read Guide** is also available, providing clear and simple information about the show's themes, characters, and structure. **Pre-recorded Audio Notes and Audio Description** are available prior to the performance. We strongly encourage and support the coordination of **Live Audio Description** and **BSL interpretation** for opening and closing speeches, the main performance, and outreach activities, working closely with event partners to make this possible. Our team is committed to creating an environment where all audiences can feel included, informed, and inspired.
